The overall opinion of respondent companies is positive that not enough skilled 'black' people are present in the construction industry and that the Construction Industry Development Board's (CIDB) contractor grading system will be an implementation for public sector contracts. It is further the opinion of these professionals that different conditions and rules should apply to Small-business entrepreneurs."
