	A:	The City estimates 1500 Neptune meters are deployed.
3.	Q:	Will the City consider AMI as an alternative proposal?
	A:	At this time, the City prefers an AMR system, but an AMI alternative proposal will be reviewed and considered if clearly labeled as such.
4.	Q:	Will the City consider epoxy or cast iron on commercial meters?
	A:	The City will consider it but may not deem it most advantageous.
5.	Q:	Are the quantities in the solicitation accurate?
	A:	Please see Part I, #14.
6.	Q:	Will the City consider a system that operates on a licensed frequency?
	A:	Yes if no additional costs to the City are incurred.
7.	Q:	What Fire Hydrant or Construction meter specifications can be provided?
8.	A:	The City seeks the respondent's best recommendation for these meters.
9.	Q:	Does the City seek Gallons-Per-Minute (gpm) reading?
	A:	Yes.
