High School

- Mr. Jason Barringer's schedule this year includes a new course, "Environmental Sustainability". This course is in the Project Lead the Way track of classes. Students who successfully complete this course will be eligible for college credit through Sinclair College. Mr. Barringer is completing an intensive training program from August 3-14 in Syracuse, NY to be certified by PTLW to teach this class.

- We will be instituting a slightly different bell schedule for 5th grade for the whole year and for the 6th grade for the second semester that will allow for more intervention for the students that need it, and enrichment for the students that do not.

Elementary

- Changes with enrollment are occurring almost daily at each of the grade levels.
- Teachers have been busy preparing their rooms for First Night on August 17th.
- Only new staff member this year is Laura Gahn, Intervention Specialist.
- Fall pictures are August 31st.
- Recently, ODE announced some changes for state testing that will take place this year. PARCC is out and all tests will be provided through AIR. Air is in the process of developing the new Reading and Math tests with information to be available later in the school year.

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- A. Third graders have two opportunities during the school year to pass the reading portion in order to meet the Third Grade Reading Guarantee. Their first opportunity will be after Thanksgiving break.
- B. The spring tests can be offered beginning April 4th. We have the option of offering two 90 minute tests or one 180 minute test. Third graders will take reading and math while 4th graders will take reading, math, and social studies.
