From the 2007 Revised Ordinances of the City of Newton, Massachusetts, Chapter 17, Article III, Division 3, *Solicitors and Canvassers*:

- Sec. 17-58** It shall be unlawful for any person to engage in business as a canvasser or solicitor calling at residences without the previous consent of the occupant for the purpose of soliciting orders, sales, subscriptions, or business of any kind, or seeking for information or donations without first having registered in the office of the Chief of Police.
- Sec. 17-64** No solicitor or canvasser, licensed or exempted from license, may use any plan, scheme or ruse which misrepresents the true status or mission of the person making the call in order to gain admission to a prospective buyer's home, office or other establishment with the purpose of making a sale of consumer goods or services.
- Sec. 17-65** No person shall deposit for the purpose of soliciting a sale, in open view on the premises of any residence, any material, display items, samples or advertising of any nature without the prior consent of the occupant.
