## PASTOR'S COMMENTS

Dear Members.

It is a joy and a privilege to greet you on this first Sunday of 2013. May all of us have a happy and blessed New Year. It is also with much joy and gratitude that I stand in the pulpit of Zion today, having completed my eighth year as Pastor of Mount Zion. This time nine years ago, we began a walk of faith as I took on the awesome responsibility of pastoring such a phenomenal church. The Lord has been good to us even with the setback of our fire six years ago on February 17, 2007. God has restored us and Zion is still moving on.

We began the month of December by sponsoring Operation Angel Tree, our Christmas Outreach Project where we ministered to the needs of several different families. What can we say about the New Members Class of 2012? We praise God for their membership and their loyalty to our church as they demonstrated their love for the Lord in a great way. 
