## PASTOR'S COMMENTS

Dear Members,

It is a joy and a privilege to greet you on this first Sunday of 2014. May all of us have a happy and blessed New Year. It is also with much joy and gratitude that I stand in the pulpit of Zion today, having completed my ninth year as Pastor of Mount Zion. This time ten years ago, we began a walk of faith as I took on the awesome responsibility of pastoring such a phenomenal church. The Lord has been good to us even with the setback of our fire seven years ago on February 17, 2007. God has restored us and Zion is still moving on.

We began the month of December by having a great evening of fun, food and fellowship at our Annual Christmas Party. What can we say about the New Members Class of 2013? We praise God for their membership and their loyalty to our church as they demonstrated their love for the Lord in a great way. Our Music Ministry under the leadership of Tony Wilkins gave us a great 8<sup>th</sup> Annual Christmas Musical Celebration. Our Drama Ministry gave us a wonderful Christmas play. Sister **LINDA HEARN**, a young lady, a new believer, committed, growing very fast, snatched quickly from us in a car accident.

Deacon **MICHAEL CURTIS** was a Deacon, a charter leader of the Vanguard Ministry, a Sunday School student and a supporter of the Lord's Kitchen. He was a gardener and tree trimmer by trade. He and his lovely wife, Sister Helen Curtis, were both faithful and active in the church.

Mother **ALICE MASHACK** was a member of Mount Zion for almost eighty five years. She was a Sunday School teacher, active worker of Circle 20 and Division E, the Mothers' Ministry, Women's Ministry and Music Ministry. She also was active in the National Council of Negro Women.

Sister **MARGARET GRACE RHODES** was one of the most unusual persons one could ever know: a complete lifetime of work and service as a circle president, leader of Division D, Sunday School teacher, program chairman and many, many other positions she held. During twenty-five years of her service, she had no physical sight.

Reverend **BOZIE STEPHENS** was a brilliant, energetic, fast-moving, dedicated young preacher taken from us at an early age. He was the Superintendent of the Bozie Stephens Young Teen Church School Department, which is now known as the Intermediate Department.

Sister **MARY DAVIS** was a very intelligent, appropriate women who joined Mount Zion in 1922. She was a church school student, choir member, and circle member. She presented the church resolutions at most homegoing services. She served as the secretary of E. Victor Villa. She accompanied Pastor on many of his trips, including Israel & Africa.

Sister **EVA GADBERRY** was a Christian mother of four, a housewife and wife for fifty-two years. She was a strict disciplinarian whose prayer was for her children to grow up successfully. One of her daughters was our former member, Janet Johnson.

Sister **BEATRICE PRENTICE** was the loving, faithful, serving wife of the Reverend F. H. Prentice, who pastored Mount Zion for thirty-four years. During those years, she served beside him as a worker in the church, community and the conventions.

Brother **HAROLD VAN NORTON** was one of the charter members of Mount Zion. He served as a very faithful usher, especially on the church parking lot.

Sister **DELLA ROBERTS** joined Mount Zion in 1938 and served faithfully as a choir member, Sunday School teacher, mission circle president and chairman of flowers. It was Sister Roberts and her husband who invited Pastor Hill Sr. to visit Mount Zion.

Reverend **EDWARD B. BASS** served Mount Zion in every capacity. He was the most faithful, loyal, trustworthy, and dependable Assistant Pastor to Pastor Edward V. Hill Sr. for almost thirty years. He was a soloist, recording artist, prayer partner, preacher, Vanguard leader, Sunday School teacher in the Young Adult Department, staff member, teacher of the Work Experience Program, teacher of the World Christian Training Center, and Pastor of the Bible Covenant Church.

Sister **EDNA CARTER** was a very quiet-mannered mother and grandmother in our church. She was a faithful member of the Mother's Board. She was the mother of Brother Sammie Atchison and great grandmother of our own First Lady Tisa Hill.

Sister **CATHERINE MOORE JAMISON** was a faithful member for thirty years. She was a very gifted and eloquent speaker who worked with the youth, served as a Bible teacher in the Missionary Society and was Corresponding Secretary of the church for over twenty years. She was the mother of Mother Alice Mashack.

Deacon **LESTER ROYAL** was a faithful church worker, deacon, Sunday School teacher, choir member, prayer partner, a witness for Jesus and a helper to those in need. He loved to talk about Jesus and he never met a stranger. His wife, Mother Hazel, is still doing the work of the Lord among us.

Deacon **NED P. LEGOHN, SR.** was Chairman of Deacons when Pastor Hill Sr. came to Zion. Pastor Hill and family lived in the Legohn home for over eight weeks until they found a home. He steered the course of this church during turbulent times. Many of his family are still with us.

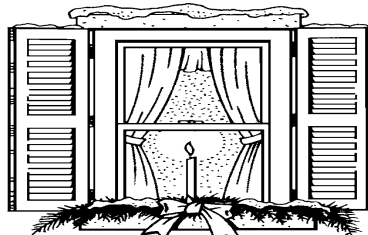
