Tips for Trick-or-Treating

For Kids:

- 1. Carry a bright flashlight with fresh batteries to illuminate sidewalks, steps and paths.
- 2. Walk on the left side of the road.
- 3. Obey ALL traffic signals and signs.
- 4. Don't cut across yards and stay out of back yards.
- 5. Review the "stop, drop and roll" procedure.
- 6. Avoid candy that has loose wrappings, is unwrapped, has puncture holes, or is homemade.
- 7. Be polite and say thanks!



For Homeowners:

- Make sure your yard is clear of such things as ladders, hoses and low flower pots.
- 2. Be sure the path and stairs to your front door are well illuminated.
- 3. Make sure paper decorations or costumes won't be blown into a flaming candle.
- 4. Try healthy food alternatives for visiting trick-or-treaters. Include packages of peanut butter crackers, single-serve boxes of cereal, packaged fruit rolls, or single-serve packages of popcorn!

Fall Home Maintenance Checklist

Mechanical Systems and Attic Area:

- ☐ Clean and test smoke alarms and carbon monoxide detectors.
- ☐ Change or clean air conditioner/furnace filter.
- ☐ Check and operate heating system. Have a professional maintain the system if necessary.

Exterior of Your Home:

- ☐ Adjust sprinkler system for winter watering schedule.
- ☐ Clean gutters and confirm that downspouts and splashblocks drain away from the house.
- ☐ Check exterior caulking and paint. Touch up as needed.
- ☐ Wash and clean windows and window screens.

Interior of Your Home:

- ☐ Follow all instructions for safe operation of any fireplace.
- ☐ Open and close windows regularly to help lubricate the tracks.
- ☐ Inspect for shrinkage damage such as minor drywall cracks and separations of wood trim. Repair as needed.

8 Ways to Save Water Without Spending a Dime

- 1. Turn the water off while brushing your teeth.
- 2. Fill a milk jug with stones and place it in your toilet tank to displace water.
- 3. Dig up an egg timer from your kitchen and use it to cut showers down to 5 minutes.
- 4. Turn off the water while shaving.
- 5. Fix toilet and faucet leaks immediately.
- 6. Don't use your toilet as a trash can.
- 7. Collect "warm-up" water to irrigate your lawn and flowerbeds.
- 8. Conserve energy. The National Renewable Energy Laboratory estimates that .47 gallons of water are lost for every kilowatt-hour of power generated by coal power plants.
