**Subject:** Participation in the Development of a New Computer-based Health Education Curriculum – *“It’s Your Game: Keep It Real”*

The Inter Tribal Council of Arizona, Inc. is pleased to invite participants of the 2012 United National Indian Tribal Youth (UNITY) National Conference to be included in an exciting new health education curriculum called, *“It’s Your Game: Keep It Real”* (IYG). IYG is an interactive evidence and computer-based curriculum aimed to promote healthy decision making about sex. We are currently in the process of adapting the IYG curriculum for American Indian/Alaska Native youth. A major piece to the computer-based curriculum are videos of interviewed youth who discuss issues such as the importance of having healthy friendships, safe dating, and knowing and respecting one’s rules.

We are seeking 40 American Indian/Alaska Native youth to be interviewed to discuss various topics in both group and individual settings during this year’s National UNITY Conference. We are also seeking groups of American Indian/Alaska Native youth to showcase modern and traditional dance in both group and individual settings. Videotaping will occur on Friday, July 6, 2012, in the afternoon and into the evening, and Saturday, July 7, 2012, in the afternoon and into the evening. Participants will be provided a \$50 incentive for their participation. The time commitment may vary depending on the activity.

#### Video Development for *"It's Your Game: Keep It Real"* and for Educational Purposes related to HIV, STD and Teen Pregnancy Prevention and Healthy Relationships Programs for American Indian and Alaska Native (AI/AN) Youth

As you are aware, HIV, sexually transmitted diseases (STD) and unintended teen pregnancy are important issues for AI/AN teens and young adults. The Inter Tribal Council of Arizona, Inc. (ITCA) is working with the University of Texas - Health Science Center at Houston to adapt an online program, called *"It's Your Game: Keep It Real"* for AI/AN youth that will raise awareness about these issues, and for educational purposes for the ITCA Teen Pregnancy Prevention Program. Both resources will contain video segments designed to teach students to make safe and responsible decisions related to dating and sexual relationships.

ITCA will be filming video segments for the aforementioned purposes at the 2012 United National Indian Tribal Youth (UNITY) National Conference. The video segments will focus on adolescent relationships, and will include discussions about healthy and unhealthy friendships, keeping personal limits despite peer pressure, the negative consequences of having sex (pregnancy, STD/HIV infection), choosing not to have sex (abstinence), and how to handle high-risk situations where alcohol and drugs are present. The video segments will not include explicit content.
