In completing your application to the MSW program, please be aware of the following:

1. The MSW courses start in the summer and are offered during the summer, fall and spring semesters. Classes are offered late afternoon (3:00 or 3:30) and evenings (6:00 or 6:30) and may be offered on Saturdays, if required. Electives taken outside of the MSW program may be offered at other times.
2. All references must complete the *MSW Reference Evaluation Form*. Advanced Standing applicants must also have their BSW field supervisor (not the task supervisor if not a social worker) or a Social Work supervisor (if working in a social service agency) complete the *Competency Assessment Form for Advanced Standing* instead of the letter of reference. All references must be professional references (i.e., professors, supervisors, work colleagues) that have direct experience with your work and/or academic potential.
3. Most courses require you to do internet literature searches. It will be to your advantage to have internet capability in your home, but this is not required.

4. If you have not met the prerequisites, you may still be accepted “conditionally,” pending the completion of the requirements within one year of admission.
