The Tasar Association of South Australia in conjunction with Brighton & Seacliff Yacht Club, Royal Port Pirie Yacht Club and Somerton Yacht Club will be conducting the 2014/15 South Australian Tasar State Championships on the 18<sup>th</sup> and 19<sup>th</sup> October 2014 at the Brighton & Seacliff Yacht Club, at the Royal Port Pirie Yacht Club on the 22<sup>nd</sup> and 23<sup>rd</sup> November 2014 and at the Somerton Yacht Club on the 28<sup>th</sup> February and 1<sup>st</sup> March 2015.

## **1. Rules**

- 1.1 The regatta will be governed by the current rules as defined ISAF.
- 1.2 The YA Special Regulations Part 2- Off the Beach Classes will apply.
- 1.3 The Rules of the World Tasar Class Association will apply. (see [www.tasar.org](http://www.tasar.org))
- 1.4 Where there is a conflict the Sailing Instructions will take precedence over the Notice of Race.
- 1.5 Appendix P may apply.

## **2. Advertising**

Advertising will be permitted in accordance with ISAF Regulation 20- Advertising Code. The forward 25% of the hull is reserved by the regatta organising committee for display of advertising by event sponsor(s).

Boats intending to carry advertising should provide details of their sponsors on the entry form attached. Entrants shall be advised if they are in conflict with the event sponsor(s). Tobacco and related product advertising shall not be permitted.

## **3. Eligibility and Entry**

- 3.1 The regatta is open to all boats of the Tasar Class that comply with the Rules of the World Tasar Class Association.
- 3.2 All skippers and crews shall be financial members of a Tasar Association which is a constituent of the World Tasar Council.
- 3.3 All skippers and crews shall be a member of a Yachting Australia affiliated sailing club. Presentation of current membership may be required. International entrants will also need to provide proof of membership to their country's ISAF Member National Authority.
- 3.4 Eligible boats may enter by completing the attached form and sending it, together with the required fee, to be received by the organising authority no later than 17<sup>th</sup> October 2014 or at the registration desk after this date.

#### 4. Fees

4.1 Required fees are as follows:

## 5. Schedule of Events

### 5.1 Registration and measurement:-

B&SYC – 18<sup>th</sup> October 2014 – 1000hrs to 1100hrs

RPPYC – 22<sup>nd</sup> November 2014 – 1000hrs to 1100hrs if required

SYC – 28th February 2015 – 1000hrs to 1100hrs if required

Or at the discretion of the Race Committee

## 5.2 Regatta briefing/meetings:-

18<sup>th</sup> October 2014 – B&SYC – 1200hrs

22<sup>nd</sup> November 2014 – RPPYC – 1200hrs if required

28<sup>h</sup> February 2015 – SYC – 1200hrs if required

### 5.3 Dates of racing:-

5.4 There will be a maximum of 3 races per day.

5.5 There shall be no warning signal after 1400 hours on the last day of racing.

## **6. Measurement**

- 6.1 Boat measurement and crew weigh-in will be in accordance with the Tasar Class Rules.
- 6.2 Boats may be inspected for safety equipment and measurement compliance at any time during the regatta.
- 6.3 It is the responsibility of each entrant to provide any supplementary weights necessary to ensure compliance with *Tasar Class Rule 29*. These must be presented at Registration. The Race Committee may reject at its discretion any form of supplementary weight it considers unsuitable.
- 6.4 Random measurement and compliance checks may be made throughout the regatta at the discretion of the Race Committee.

## **7. Sailing Instructions**

Printed copies of the sailing instructions will be available at registration and on the internet ([www.tasar.com.au](http://www.tasar.com.au)) after the 18<sup>th</sup> October 2014.

## **8. Venue**

The regatta will be conducted by Brighton & Seacliff Yacht Club and Somerton Yacht Club on the waters of Gulf St Vincent and by the Royal Port Pirie Yacht Club on the waters of Spencer Gulf.

## **9. The Courses**

The courses to be sailed shall consist of (approximately) equilateral triangles, trapezoid or windward returns or as described in the Sailing Instructions.

## **10. Scoring**

- 10.1 12 races, up to 3 per day, are scheduled and four are required to be completed to constitute a series.
- 10.2 When 1 to 4 races are completed, a boat's series score will be the total of her scores.
- 10.3 When 5 to 8 races are completed, a boat's series score will be the total of her scores excluding her worst score.
- 10.4 When 9 or more races are completed, a boat's series score will be the total of her scores excluding her two worst scores.
- 10.5 When 12 or more races are completed, a boat's series score will be the total of her scores excluding her three worst scores.

## **11. Support Boats**

- 11.1 Team leaders, coaches and other support personnel shall stay at least 100 metres outside areas where boats are racing from the time of the preparatory signal for the first

division to start until all boats have finished or the race committee signals a postponement, general recall or abandonment.

- 11.2 Support boats shall be marked by conspicuously displaying a burgee of the club they are representing.
- 11.3 Support boats shall not signal to competitors by any means during a race.
- 11.4 Support boats are required to render assistance if requested to do so by the race committee or a competitor.

## **12. Radio Communications**

A boat shall neither make radio transmissions while racing nor receive radio communications not available to all boats. This restriction also applies to mobile telephones.

## **13. Venue Access**

Access to, and boat storage at the venue will be available from, 17<sup>th</sup> Oct at B&SYC, 21<sup>st</sup> Nov at RPPYC and 28<sup>th</sup> Feb at SYC. Access to storage outside of these dates must be arranged on an individual basis with the venue.

## **14. Prizes**

Prizes will be given as follows:

- Perpetual trophies for the Championship
- Other prizes may be awarded arbitrarily by the race organisers.

## **15. Disclaimer of Liability**

Competitors participate in the regatta entirely at their own risk. Attention is drawn to *Rule 4, Decision to race*. The organising authority will not accept any liability for material damage or personal injury or death sustained in conjunction with or prior to, during, or after the regatta.

## **16. Insurance**

Each participating boat shall be insured with valid third-party liability insurance with a minimum cover of not less than AUD \$5,000,000 (recommended AUD \$10,000,000).
