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LETTER OF REQUEST FOR THE SACRAMENT OF CONFIRMATION

One of the requirements for receiving the Sacrament of Confirmation is write a letter of intent to Bishop Pepe.

- In order to make the task easy and enjoyable for the candidate, we have created an outline.
- This outline should be reviewed with the candidates, parents and/or sponsor when writing the letter. If the candidate, together with his/her parents, in consultation with the sponsor/mentor, and Pastor has decided that he/she desires to receive the Sacrament of Confirmation, he/she is to make that request in writing.
- Preferably, this letter is to be typewritten; though *neatly* handwritten is acceptable. Please make sure the letter is typed neatly and doesn't contain doodle marks or pictures.
- Below is a sample letter of request, please use your own words.
- Letter must be submitted to your Confirmation teacher/coordinator by February 1, 2015. This will be forwarded to the Bishop's Office prior to the date of Confirmation.

She was blind for the last seven years of her life, but her prayer life and the spiritual consolation she received from the Lord helped her radiate joy in the midst of suffering. She died at age 53.)
