4. Participated in a comparable national or state music event.

Piano:

1. Been named a district winner in performance for Oklahoma Music Teachers Association Senior Auditions; OR
2. Been named a state, regional, or national winner of the Music Teachers National Association High School Audition; OR
3. Received the Guild High School Diploma; OR
4. Received a comparable national or state honor in piano.

Visual Art:

1. Successfully completed the jury process and had work exhibited in Young Talent in Oklahoma; OR
2. Successfully completed the jury process and had work exhibited in the Scholastic Art or Oklahoma City University Print and Drawing competitions; OR
3. Successfully completed the jury process and participated in the Oklahoma Summer Arts Institute; OR
