VCLA is the only **countywide** community leadership program available in Ventura County. The program involves participants in practical and experiential activities that provide communication and interaction opportunities with key decision-makers in the public, private and nonprofit sectors. It is a ten-month program that includes one full-day session each month from September through June.

The VCLA curriculum is updated each year to address those timely issues most important to the county. In the program, participants are involved with: an opening session; a series of day-long focus sessions which address issues including housing, transportation, agriculture, economic development, education, governance, health care, housing, local demographics, nonprofits and volunteerism, cultural arts and public safety; a two-and-a- half-day trip to Sacramento to study current legislative issues; an immersion activity; and a group project that is designed and implemented by each cohort.
