



Announcing our Spring Musical Theatre Workshops & Recital

A semester of song and dance with a little something for everyone







Join us this spring as we prepare three very different units to combine into one recital showcasing the talents of over 100 students. There will be dozens of opportunities for features and solos. The focus this semester will be on developing the individual skills involved in musical theatre and then showcasing them in a performance. Read about the workshops below and see the following page for audition information. There is some overlapping of age groups; we reserve the right to blend the age groups as needed to allow as many kids to participate as possible in a way that makes sense based on the audition pool. Please feel free to let us know your preferences and concerns by attaching a note to your audition form.

Beginning workshop – Grades 1-5 – "A Year With Frog and Toad, Kids" – This is a charming, 20-minute, minimalistic version of the Broadway musical which will feature our youngest students singing, speaking and TAP DANCING. There is no experience necessary to participate. The program will get the kids tapping quickly, even if they are absolute beginners. Students will need to provide their own black tap shoes. Many featured solos are available for various ages and genders. There is a \$50 instruction fee. Practices are Wednesday from 4:00-5:30 p.m. beginning January 13. After auditions/enrollment, students will be placed into subgroups and some sub-groups may have some days off.

Intermediate workshop – Grades 4 & up – "Schoolhouse Rock, Live, Jr." – This will be a 35 - minute, fast-paced recital of favorite selections from Saturday mornings of the 70s. The songs are loosely strung together in a story about a new teacher preparing for his first day of school. This material is exciting to dance to and interesting to learn from. There is a \$50 instruction fee. Students will need to provide their own white athletic shoes. Practices will be Tuesday and Thursday 4:00-5:30 p.m. beginning January 12. After auditions/enrollment, students will be placed into subgroups and some sub-groups may have some days off.

Advanced workshop – Grades 9-12 – "Selections of Movin' Out, the music of Billy Joel" - This workshop will be whatever the vision of selected advanced students wish it to be. We are expecting approximately 20 minutes of these classic songs with advanced students singing in solos or small ensembles, sometimes dancing while they sing or sometimes singing while others are dancing/ acting to the music. We are open to the idea of student directed or choreographed pieces in this workshop. The schedule will be flexed around the individuals involved in each piece... don't let the rehearsal calendar scare you, we are blocking off a whole bunch of "possible" instruction time, but will work the selected students into special groups based on their other spring commitments. Students interested in this workshop should email Nicole (nicolezweifel@yahoo.com) discussing their desire to participate, any ideas for student directing etc. and also a schedule of their conflicts. There is a \$25 participation fee and student purchases of dance supplies/clothing will depend on the pieces performed.



Calendar Policy –We take great effort to make a detailed calendar that allows students to only come to rehearsal when we are working on material in which they are involved. For this reason, if a student requests to be absent from a rehearsal or performance date, and if this request was not submitted by Callbacks (December 11), then the absence may not be excused and the student may face adverse action including being replaced by another student for the performance and production. Requests for absences received after December 11th may or may not be approved based on the discretion of the directors. In determining whether to grant the request for the absence, the directors shall take into consideration factors including, but not limited to: (1) whether the absence or absence or absence date change, the student or the parent/guardian may appeal in writing the directors' decision to the County Superintendent or his designee must be filed within three (3) business days of the directors' decision to deny the absence. The decision of the County Superintendent or his designee and shall be final.
