Nearly 6,000 vendors have registered to date. Registration is simple and takes only a few minutes. You just need to go to our website at www.njstart.gov and enter your company information to get the process started.

The website's Registered Vendor Search engine enables the public to easily find registered vendors by name, county, or zip code. This new feature also improves the visibility of small-, minority-, women- and veteran-owned businesses.

We have also deployed New Jersey's first-ever Vendor Library in NJSTART, which allows vendors to complete, store and update required forms in their own secure file on our system. As you requested, we have streamlined these forms to cut red tape. These convenient features should make things easier for you.

Maintaining Categories and Certifications

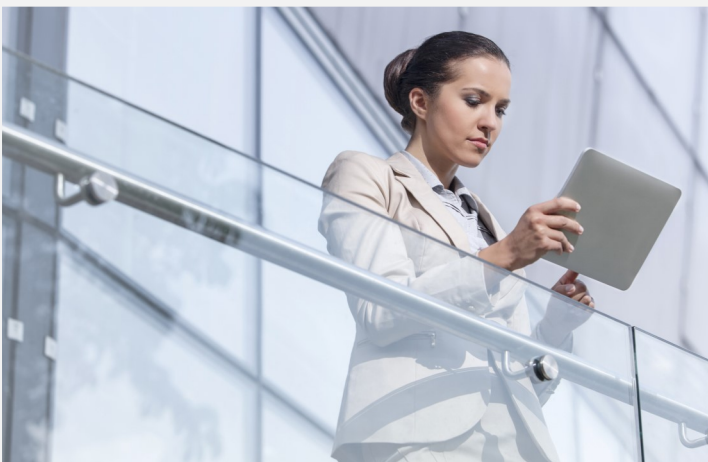
The NJSTART Vendor Library is available now, where you can take advantage of the many new “one-stop-shop” features that were developed at your request.

We have pre-populated some of the fields from other State systems of record for certifications that are required for your company to do business with the State, so please take a moment to log into NJSTART to review the “Terms, Categories, and Certifications” section and ensure the information in your organization’s profile is accurate.

Pay particular attention to the “Business Registration” category to confirm that the checked selection is current.

Vendors can complete forms online and upload certifications to their vendor profile. This will cut down on the amount of paperwork that was once required with each proposal.

You can also update your profile in real time and have multiple users on your team work on proposal documents.


