2015/2016 **Grade 11 Merit Scholarships (Internal) Application Form**

This scholarship is intended for three current CDNIS Grade 10 students who will be enrolled at CDNIS in the IB Diploma Programme for the 2015-2016 and 2016-2017 academic years. The scholarship includes financial support up to and including HKD 50 000 for each of the next two summers to cover the costs associated with a programme or initiative of the student's choice. Applicants are required to submit this application, a one page essay outlining the details of the programme, and a reference from a subject teacher, counsellor, coach, or advisor relevant to the student's programme of choice.

The school is seeking applicants with a strong academic track record who are striving to enhance their portfolio by continuing their studies in a specified subject area, conducting academic research, or engaging in and/or initiating a community service project. The applicant must complete Grade 10 at CDNIS and be in very good academic standing with a history not only of good grades, but extensive involvement in the school community. The successful applicant will be eligible to receive this funding for the Summers of 2015 and 2016, provided he/she maintains good academic standing and proper conduct at the school. Withdrawing from the school before graduation will mean that the student must reimburse the scholarship funds.
