## Thanksgiving: A Time for Grace

Thanksgiving seems to be a perfect time to have a special prayer offered at the table.

What are some ideas for leading grace during this day of thanks?

One idea to try is a "popcorn prayer," which lets family members individually speak up and offer thanks for the blessings in their lives.

It could be as simple as starting: "We give God thanks for ..." and then seeing where this somewhat spontaneous prayer takes your family.

Keep remarks simple and brief; after all, the turkey is getting cold. Express honest thanks to the being in which you believe for not only the food you're about to enjoy but the ability to spend the holidays surrounded by loved ones. Because Thanksgiving is an ideal time to give general thanks, speak briefly about other topics of which you're thankful. Potential ideas include the health

of your family, the freedom you enjoy in your country and the emotional or physical blessings in your life. Hold hands as a group to share the moment.

Have the children lead grace during this day of thanks. Don't put pressure on the kids to feel as if they need to "perform" a special Thanksgiving Day prayer. Instead, let them say what they feel in their hearts.

After all, a vital aspect of prayer is simply allowing the Spirit to open our attention to Christ's presence in and around us. The exact words we speak aren't as important.

# Pastor Rena's Perspective

*Mark 2:27 "Jesus said to them, "The Sabbath was made for man, not man for the Sabbath."*

SABBATH – Some questions about Sabbath?

What is Sabbath? Who should honor Sabbath?

Sabbath is actually a Hebrew word that means – to refrain from the ordinary activities of the week. It means to take refuge in time with God. It means relaxation and refreshment. Sabbath is not only for the body, but for the mind and soul as well. Sabbath is for everyone. Our bodies need to be at rest so that they may rebuild energy and endurance and strength. Our minds also need a time when they are cleared of troubling thoughts of things we cannot

fix, of things we should have or should not have done. Almost the most important aspect to Sabbath is resting your soul. That does not mean taking a nap during church. It means emptying it of bitterness, fear, anger, distress, and hate. Make room for God in your soul. You will find when you have made room for God there is a lot less room for other things to creep in. Allowing God into your soul also allows him into your mind and body, giving you a feeling of peace and newness. And that is something to be thankful for.

Secretary's Report: Motion was made and seconded to accept the secretary's report. Motion carried.

Congregation Council Reports:

- ~ Augustana has not met since last meeting.
- ~ Bergen is doing well. Looking into a Portuguese Bible for a youth congregation member.
- ~ St. Lucas has not met since last meeting.
- ~ Swede Home has not met since last meeting.
- ~ Yellow Medicine is doing well. Discussed snow announcement process and FLY account.

Financial Reports for August was received and filed, subject to approval by audit.

Pastoral/Staff Reports:

In their report, Pr. Dave and Pr. Rena announced Pr. Rena became a representative for the La Qui Parle Conference. They both attended the Fall Theological Conference. A major topic discussed at the Conference was policies to protect youth and vulnerable adults. We will be updating our policy in the near future to continue keeping everyone safe. Pr. Dave requested that each church give them a full year calendar of events happening throughout the year (no need for dates, just months).

New Business:

~ Distribute Offering from 10-Year Celebration/Budget Line for Mission - \$660 raised from 10-Year Celebration Offering will be divided up into 5 areas: \$330 will go to the Water Angel Project, \$82.50 will go to the Clarkfield Food Shelf, \$82.50 will go to the Granite Falls Food Shelf, \$82.50 will go to the Montevideo Food Shelf, and \$82.50 will go to the Marshall Food Shelf. It was decided the \$600

for our Mission Budget will go toward scholarships for orphaned children in South Africa, our sister conference, or financial based needs. Right now we help to support 24 children. One of them graduates this year and is coming to America to study to be a doctor.

~ 2015 Budget – Need each church's Confirmed Contributing Congregational Member Number to get started on the budget.

~ Homemade banner for the Parish – Each church will have it for 2 months and then pass it on to the next one, alphabetically, so it's displayed all over the Parish.
