The purpose of this training is to provide an overview of cognitive screening tool using The Mini Mental State Exam (MMSE). This training will include information on the purpose of the screening tool; cognitive domains covered by this screening tool; how to administer and score the MMSE. The training will review information on cultural/social factors specific to individuals in Los Angeles County, how they may impact scores on this test, and how to account for them in interpretation of score. In addition the training will review video-taped session of experts administering the MMSE, within the context of DMH 2.7 parameters. Finally, a review of documentation and claiming requirements as they apply to the use of the MMSE will be covered.

TARGET AUDIENCE: DMH and contracted clinicians who work with Older Adult clients

OBJECTIVES: As a result of attending this training, participants should be able to:

1. Illustrate administering, scoring and interpret MMSE results.
2. Identify social/cultural considerations relevant to tests use and interpretation of scores to the Los Angeles County mental health consumers.
3. Identify at least 5 differential diagnoses that may be suggested by scores at or below cut-off on the MMSE; and identify options available for further testing to clarify diagnosis and identify appropriate treatment.
