ASSUMPTION OF RISK, RELEASE AND INDEMNIFICATION AGREEMENT AND PHOTO RELEASE

WHEREAS, the undersigned (“USER”) has requested the permission of JD Fieldhouse LLC its sucesors and assigns, **BLOOMFIELD HILLS SCHOOLS**, Joe Dumars and Investors Limited (collectively the “Released Parties”) to use the facilities located at 45300 Mound Road, Shelby Township, Michigan, 45376 Mound Road, Shelby Township, Michigan and/or 43655 Utica Road, Sterling Heights, Michigan and/or the Bloomfield Hills Schools (the “Overall Facilities”) for basketball and/or volleyball as well as other sports activities, the viewing of sports activities and other entertainment related activities (collectively the “Activities”); and

WHEREAS, the Released Parties has approved such use, subject to the terms and conditions provided herein.

NOW THEREFORE, for and in consideration of the foregoing and the mutual conditions, covenants and agreement contained herein and for other good and valuable consideration, the receipt and sufficiency of which are hereby acknowledged, the parties hereto agree as follows:

- The Released Parties Qualified Permission.** Released Parties, relying on the execution by USER (as such term is defined in Section 7 below) of this Agreement, hereby grants permission to USER to use the Overall Facilities for the Activities, subject to all of the terms and conditions provided herein.
- Assumption of Risk.** USER ACKNOWLEDGES THAT (A) USER IS USING THE OVERALL FACILITIES AT THEIR OWN RISK WHETHER OR NOT AN ATTENDANT IS PRESENT, (b) THE ACTIVITIES TO BE ENGAGED IN BY USER MAY BE DANGEROUS AND MAY INVOLVE THE RISK OF SERIOUS INJURY, DEATH AND/OR PROPERTY DAMAGE AND (c) USER ASSUMES FULL RESPONSIBILITY FOR ANY INJURIES, DAMAGES OR LOSSES WHICH MAY OCCUR TO OR BE OCCASIONED BY USER IN OR ABOUT THE OVERALL FACILITIES.
- Compliance with Rules and Regulations.** USER shall use the Overall Facilities at USER’s risk and in compliance with all rules and regulations relating to each and every portion of the Overall Facilities promulgated by the Released Parties, its partners and/or agents from time to time.
- Release.** USER and its heirs and family members (the “Releasing Parties”) covenant not to sue and hereby release, remise and forever discharge Released Parties and its past, present or future officers, directors, agents, employees, partners and representatives (the “Released Parties”) from and against all actions, causes of action, suits, damages, judgments, claims, counterclaims, demands, liabilities and obligations whatsoever, known or unknown, direct or indirect, liquidated or contingent, at law or in equity, which the Releasing Parties or any of them now have, ever had or hereafter can, shall or may have against the Released Parties for or by reason of any matter, cause or thing whatsoever occurring, arising out of, related to or in connection with the Overall Facilities, whether or not arising out of future events.
- Indemnification.** The Releasing Parties shall at all times be responsible for and protect, indemnify, defend and save harmless the Released Parties from and against any and all loss, cost, damage or expense arising out of or from, relating to, in connection with or occasioned by (a) the use or intended use of any portion of the Overall Facilities by USER, (b) any accident or other occurrence causing injury to the person or property of USER relating to such use or intended use or (c) any claim, counterclaim, cause of action, demand or suit by or on behalf of a minor child USER not a signatory to this Agreement brought against the Released Parties relating to the Overall Facilities.
- Continued Use of the Overall Facilities.** User acknowledges that the terms and conditions of this Agreement shall relate to the first time USER uses any portion of the Overall Facilities and all USER’s future use of any portion of the Overall Facilities, whether such future use arises out of an agreement between (i) the Released Parties and USER, (ii) the Released Parties and any third party using the Facilities, or (iii) no further agreement at all, it being the intention of the Released Parties that this Agreement shall be a continuing assumption of risk, waiver and indemnification for each and every time USER uses any portion of the Overall Facilities.
- Defined Terms.** The term “USER” shall mean the undersigned and those individuals listed below for whom the undersigned is a legal guardian. By listing said minor children below, the undersigned does hereby represent that he/she is in fact a legal guardian of the children so listed and agrees to indemnify, defend and hold the Release Parties harmless from and against any and all causes of action arising out of or in any way connected with any defect in User’s capacity to act as legal guardian. Further, USER acknowledges and agrees that all of the limitations on liability and other terms contained in this Agreement themselves.
- Term.** This Agreement shall be in full force and effect during such time as the Released Parties has not revoked user’s permission to use the Overall Facilities. User’s obligations under Sections 2, 4, 5 and 6 above shall survive the termination or expiration of this Agreement.
- Photo Release.** USER acknowledges that during the course of using the Overall Facilities, his/her photograph may be taken by the Released Parties or an agent or representative of the Released Parties. USER hereby grants the Released Parties permission to use any such photograph taken of USER for use in materials promoting the Released Parties. Such use may include publication in the Released Parties newspaper, banquet brochure, restaurant brochure, general advertising and other vehicles that may be distributed to or otherwise seen by large numbers of individuals and potential patrons of the Released Parties.

Dear Coach,

Thank you for taking the time to invest in the lives of children in our area. It is hard for me to imagine my life without the positive influence that coaches had upon me...particularly those volunteers who worked with me as a young man.

It has always been our feeling that coaches play a critical role in delivering a quality basketball league program. Coaches often have an overriding impact on the experience of the player, almost always in a positive way, but sometimes negative as well. It is with this in mind that I wanted to express to you a few principals that I believe are critical to the role of coaches in our program. Please consider the following:

Referee Policy: Coaches should expect that referees will make mistakes, some of which will impact your team in a negative way. Joe Dumars' Fieldhouse invites feedback about referee performance but insists that such feedback be communicated exclusively with league management and not with the referees in a location away from the field of play. Verbal or physical abuse of referees will not be tolerated and may result in suspension of the coach for all or part of the season. We expect your assistance in helping participants focus on those parts of the game within their control and not on the actions or inactions of referees, even when (or especially when) the players have suffered the burden of a bad call.

Conduct: We understand that coaches employ a variety of means to obtain the best performance from their players. Having said this, we expect that coaches will maintain a largely positive disposition towards their players, opposing coaches, opposing players and league administrators. In the event that a coach is the subject of mistreatment by another coach, player, referee or fan, we expect coaches to behave in a manner that acts to defuse the situation so that a non-hostile environment can be reestablished as soon as possible.

Thanks for taking the time to consider these ideas and for playing a critical role in the success of the program.

Coaches Code of Ethics

- I will place the emotional and physical well being of my players ahead of a personal desire to win.
- I will treat each player as an individual, remembering the large range of emotional and physical development for the same age group.
- I will encourage good sportsmanship by demonstrating positive support for all players, coaches, and officials at every game or practice.
- I will do my best to provide a safe playing situation for my players.
- I will promise to review and practice the basic first aid principles needed to treat injuries of my players.
- I will do my best to organize practices that are fun and challenging for all my players.
- I will lead by example in demonstrating fair play and sportsmanship to all my players
- I will provide a sports environment for my team that is free of drugs, tobacco, and alcohol, and I will refrain from their use at all games and practices.
- I will be knowledgeable in the rules of each sport that I coach, and I will teach these rules to my players.
- I will use those coaching techniques appropriate for each of the skills that I teach.
- I will remember that I am a youth sports coach, and that the game is for children and not adults.

As coach of a youth team participating at Joe Dumars Fieldhouse in the Bloomfield Hills Schools, I will make sure the **Code of Ethics** is distributed and discussed with **all Players** and **Parents**.

Coaches are responsible for making sure all players and parents uphold these ethics. Anyone not following these rules will be dealt with accordingly by a Fieldhouse League Director. This could include facility suspensions ranging from 1 game to an indefinite period, for all coaches, players, parents and spectators.

- I will do my very best to make youth sports fun for my child.
- I will ask my child to treat other players, coaches, fans, and officials, with respect regardless of race, sex, creed, or ability.
- I promise to help my child enjoy the youth sports experience by doing whatever I can, such as being a respectable fan, or assisting with coaching.
- I will require that my child's coach upholds the Coaches' Code of Ethics.

Players Code of Ethics

- I hereby pledge to be positive about my youth sports experience and accept responsibility for my participation by following this Players' Code of Ethics Pledge.
- I will encourage good sportsmanship from fellow players, coaches, officials and parents at every game and practice by demonstrating good sportsmanship.
- I will attend every practice and game that I can, and will notify my coach if I cannot.
- I will do my very best to listen and learn from my coaches.
- I will treat my coaches, other players, officials and fans with respect regardless of race, sex, creed, or abilities and I will expect to be treated accordingly.
- I deserve to have fun during my sports experience and will alert parents or coaches if it stops being fun!
- I deserve to play in an environment that is free of drugs, tobacco, and alcohol and expect adults to refrain from their use at all youth sports events.
- I will encourage my parents to be involved with my team in some capacity because it's important to me.
- I will remember that sports are an opportunity to learn and have fun.
