



The antenuptial contract must be signed in the presence of a Notary PRIOR to the marriage and must after signature, within 3 months, be registered in a Deeds Office.

And the Appearers declare that a marriage has been agreed upon and is intended to be solemnised between them and, in contemplation of the marriage, they have contracted and agreed with each other as follows:

2. The accrual system referred to in Chapter 1 of the Matrimonial Property Act No. 88 of 1984 as amended from time to time is hereby expressly excluded in accordance with the provisions of Section 2 of the said Act.
