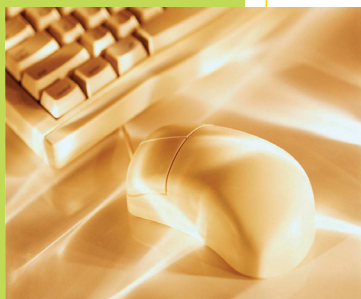

Instructions & Policies

There are two methods of registering for Summer Camp programs this year:

1. Fill out the registration form on the opposite page (front and back), one form for each child registering, and mail it in to the appropriate registrar listed for your District or Conference camp. Please be sure to fill in all of the blanks completely and include appropriate registration fees. Your space at camp will not be reserved until all information and necessary fees are received by the registrar.
2. Log on to our website at www.CalPacCamps.org and click on "Register for Summer Camp". This link will take you to our Online Registration System located on a secured server hosted by Thriva. Follow the links and fill in all of the required fields. Payment for registration fees can be made online using MasterCard, Visa, Discover or E-check or mailed in separately.

Upon receipt of registration via mail or through our online system, a confirmation packet will be sent to you by email and/or snail mail. Please read the confirmation packet carefully as it will detail additional information necessary to prepare you for camp.

Late Fees and Cancellations

Please carefully note that each camp has a different registration deadline and late fee. Our online registration system will calculate the late fee automatically depending on when you actually register. For paper registrations, please add in any additional fees necessary on the form.

All camps will follow the same cancellation and refund schedule:

Cancellation made >>>>>	Amount refunded >>>>>
2 months before beginning of camp:	Full refund of registration fees
1 month before beginning of camp:	Registration fee minus \$20 service charge
2 weeks before beginning of camp:	Registration fee minus \$50 service charge
* No refunds given less than 2 weeks before beginning of camp!

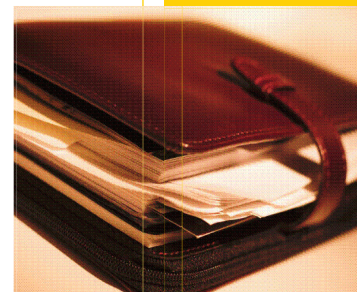
