NATIONAL HBPA SKY CRUISE TERMS & CONDITIONS

SHIP REGISTRY: The Norwegian Sky is registered in the Bahamas.

DOCUMENTATION REQUIREMENTS: Guests need a valid passport OR proof of citizenship and a valid government-issued photo I.D. (driver's license with a photo) or any other WHTI compliant document. Proof of Citizenship examples include: an original or state certified copy of a U.S. birth certificate, original certificate of U.S. naturalization, original certificate of U.S. citizenship, or a U.S. Consular report of your birth abroad. **Baptismal paper and hospital certificates of birth are not acceptable.** U.S. citizens under the age of 16 do not require a government-issued photo ID. Any passenger traveling without proper documentation may be prevented from boarding the ship or from entering a country & may be subject to fines. No refunds will be given for individuals who fail to bring proper documentation and are denied boarding.

In addition, government regulations require all guests must provide the cruise line with key personal information prior to sailing. National HBPA acknowledges that Norwegian Cruise Line will not release any passenger documents until complete passenger information has been provided for all program guests, including but not limited to full legal first and last name, citizenship, age, and any other legally required immigration information for non U.S. citizens such as nationality, alien registration number, passport number, birth date, etc.

LIMITING TERMS AND CONDITIONS: National HBPA and L&K are acting only in the capacity of liaison for the suppliers and/or contractors who are to furnish the transportation and/or other services specified including, but not limited to, Experient, Inc., Norwegian Cruise Line, Hotels, Airlines, Ground Operators, etc. (hereinafter referred to as "Suppliers"). As liaison, the sole liability of National HBPA and L&K, whether monetary damages or otherwise, is limited to the amount of compensation received from said Suppliers in arranging said transportation and/or services on behalf of NHBPA participates. If any Supplier shall cancel their specified transportation and/or other services for any reason, NHBPA and L&K are only obligated to refund deposits received upon advice and its receipt of the refund from said Supplier.

In the event that Norwegian Cruise Line cancels the cruise program, neither NHBPA nor L&K shall have any further liability under this Agreement as of the date of such cancellation. Further, Norwegian Cruise Line would be obligated to refund all payments made up to the date of cancellation.

Should the cruise program outlined in this Agreement be affected by circumstances beyond the control of Norwegian Cruise Line, NHBPA and L&K agree to use best efforts to negotiate a mutually agreeable resolution between all parties.

NHBPA and L&K shall not be liable for any personal injury, property damage, accident, delay, inconvenience, change in itinerary or accommodations, failure of performance or other irregularity which may occur whether due to (1) wrongful, negligent or arbitrary acts or omissions on the part of the Suppliers, their employees or others not under the direct and sole control of L&K, (2) defects or failures of any conveyance, equipment or instrumentality under the control of the Suppliers, and, but not limited to, (3) or otherwise. In any event, NHBPA and L&K shall not be liable for any consequence resulting from Acts of God, fire, acts of governments or other authorities, war, civil disturbances, terrorism, riots, strikes, thefts, pilferage, epidemics, quarantines or dangers incident to the sea, land and air or any other event that is beyond NHBPA and L&K's control.

Participates also agree to the terms and conditions of the cruise or services as set forth in the passenger ticket contract and/or brochures of the Suppliers.

NCL FACTS:

A minor is defined as an individual under 18 years of age at the time of embarkation.

A young adult is defined as an individual between the ages of 18 and 20.
