Jan.-June	<p><i>UNIT III- WELCOME TO THE JUNGLE</i></p> <p><u>Concepts-</u> Artist Study-Henri Rousseau, low-relief paper art, texture, pattern, overlapping, theme art, landscape, balance, picture plane, foreground, middleground, background, art interpretation (no wrong answer), organic shapes, animal/jungle studies, complementary colors, art can be “wacky” and dream-like, puppet-making, texture, scale (big=important)</p> <p><u>Projects-</u> Cut paper jungle scene, art interpretation “<i>The Sleeping Gypsy</i>”, <u>Dropping in on Rousseau</u> story book, virtual jungle safari</p> <p><u>Materials/Media-</u> slides, books, animal print paper, duet paper, construction paper, glue stix, paper, pencils, leaf and animal templates, puppet/figure template, brad clips, wallpaper, wrapping paper, textured papers</p>	10	3-07

	<p><i>UNIT V- COLOR THEORY-THE COLOR WHEEL</i></p> <p><u>Concepts-</u> painting techniques, color mixing/creation, primary, secondary, and intermediate colors, tints, shades, color wheel, using color to make an original art work</p> <p><u>Projects-</u> Color wheel painting, mixing colors, cutting painted surfaces to create art work (2-D or paper mache mosaic bowl)</p> <p><u>Materials/Media-</u> acrylic paint, brushes, color wheel phptocopies, scissors, glue, construction paper, pencils, marker, mache paste or shaper paper</p>	7
