Introduction to Person-Centred Facilitation Two Day Workshop

Opportunities will be provided to practice facilitation strategies and action methods suitable for leading groups, delivering training and giving presentations. The course delivery will model facilitative teaching.

Course outcomes:

At the end of this person-centred facilitation course, participants will be able to:

- 1. Discuss the elements of person centred facilitation both theoretical and practical
- 2. Implement a range of person centred facilitation strategies
- 3. Apply action methods to working groups and the delivery of training
- 4. Structure sessions using facilitative teaching for training and presentations
- 5. Develop a toolkit of strategies for use within the role of facilitator

Course content

This person-centred facilitation course covers the following topics:

- The development of the group. What is facilitation? Culture of the group; Individual and group purpose; Definitions.
- Facilitation as a Leadership Style; The Elements and Principles of Facilitation; Values, Beliefs & Behaviours of Facilitators.
- Listening.
- The Scope of Facilitations: The Facilitation of Self The Facilitation of Others, Facilitation of a Groups
- Strategies for Facilitation; Floor Maps, Opinion Maps.
- Facilitation Practice; The Facilitation of Another Intervening.
- Facilitator Competency A Model of Facilitator Competencies.
- A Possible Structure for a Facilitated Session. Achieving Completion and Closure; Completion.
