Date: Friday. June 5, 2015 Time: 10:30 AM — 4:30 PM

Location: Ho'omaluhia Botanical Gardens, Kaneohe

Participants: Hickam Field staff dependents. Age requirement: between 5 - 12 years of age and accompanied by parent or guardian. Due to space limitations at the park, participants will be limited to the first 200 registrants.

Admission Fee: Free! [hosted by the "Friends of Hickam" (FOH)]

#### **Tournament Rules & Format**

- 1. All fish must be caught on bamboo fishing poles and bait that will he provided by FOH to qualify for prizes. Rod and Reel fishing is not allowed in the tournament. Only one pole per angler and all hooks must be barbless. <u>Only registered participants qualify for prizes.</u>
- 2. Participants must release all fish caught.
- 3. All entrants shall be confined to fishing from the shoreline, only in designated areas, and must be accompanied by parent or guardian. The designated fishing area is 600 yards wide and is stocked with Small Mouth Bass, Catfish, Red Devil Fish & Tilapia.
- 4. Fish will be measured by length (from the tip of the nose to the notch in the center of the tail) and the minimum qualifying fish must be no smaller than 4 inches long. Measurement is made to the next ¼ inch. In the event of a tie, the keiki that is the youngest in age will be declared the winner. Fishing Marshals (orange vest) will be posted in the fishing areas to measure your catch and will be equipped with extra fishing tackle and bait.
- 5. Prizes will be awarded in both boys and girls divisions. Trophies will be presented for 1st, 2nd and 3rd place for "Largest Fish" categories and one for the "Most Fish" category.
- 6. Fishing will start at 1:00 PM and will conclude at 2:30 PM.
- 7. Medical personnel will be at the Command Center to provide first aid if needed.
- 8. Transport Vehicles will be parked at the Command Center for restroom transportation.
- 9. Good luck practice safety at all times, and have a fun day!
