## PREPARING FOR WORSHIP...

Today is known as Palm Sunday. Just six days before His crucifixion on Golgotha, Jesus had come into Jerusalem with acclaim and the shouts of the crowd to honor His coming to town. As a part of this reception for Jesus, the people had laid their outer garments and palm leaves on His path. Just five days later, we find Jesus sharing a final meal with His disciples in the upper room and then going out to the Garden of Gethsemane. Jesus goes off alone to pray for the Father in Heaven to give Him the strength to face the cross and death. We will look at different persons involved in this event and their response to the situation. But our main focus will be on Jesus in prayer as He seeks the Father to strengthen Him so that He can complete His mission. Jesus didn't wait till He was on the cross to pray, nor had He really waited to pray just in the garden. We read on several occasions in the New Testament about Jesus spending time in prayer so that He could continue to face all the people and situations that came His way. In Gethsemane, we see the culmination of His prayers for strength to fulfill His mission.

R.A. Torrey stated "The reason why many fail in battle is because they wait until the hour of battle. The reason why others succeed is because they have gained their victory on their knees long before the battle came...Anticipate your battles; fight them on your knees before temptation comes, and you will always have victory." May we learn from Jesus' example and receive God's strength!


