From the Pastor

Scientists at NASA built a gun specifically to launch standard four-pound dead chickens at the windshields of airliners, military jets and the space shuttle, all traveling at maximum velocity. The idea is to simulate the frequent incidents of collisions with airborne fowl to test the strength of the windshields. British engineers heard about the gun and were eager to test it on the windshields of their new high-speed trains. Arrangements were made and a gun was sent to the British engineers. When the gun was fired, the engineers stood shocked as the chicken hurled out of the barrel, crashed into the shatter-proof shield, smashed it to smithereens, blasted through the control console, snapped the engineer's back-rest in two, and embedded itself in the back wall of the cabin, like an arrow shot from a bow. The horrified Brits sent NASA the disastrous results of the experiment, along with the designs of the windshield and begged the U.S. scientists for suggestions. NASA responded with a one-line memo—"Defrost the chickens first!" (*True story*)

Sometimes the most obvious of all directions needs to be explained. In this weekend's Gospel on this most-amazing feast, Jesus explains that he is the bread of life. Thus, as we share in the Eucharist, we share him. More than a symbol, it is a sharing of the very person of the risen Christ. Seems obvious, but it needed to be explained, as it has been over and over throughout our Church's history. Perhaps, even those of us who truly believe this may cause doubts in the minds of others, not intentionally, but because we don't always act as though we are the living Body of Christ. We have not become what we have eaten. Our example in everyday life speaks volumes to those who wonder whether it is all real or not. May we be a convincing factor in the ongoing discussion about whether we are receiving the real body and blood of Christ is the Eucharist, using words, as St. Francis would suggest, only when absolutely necessary!

“How can this man give us his flesh to eat?”

The Jews quarreled over the words of Jesus – which sure seems reasonable to me. I cannot imagine, no matter how good a fellow might be, that I would agree to take a bite out of a man’s arm as he extends it! How are any of us to make sense of it?

Scripture scholars date the writing of the Gospel of John somewhere between 90-110 AD, which means the people who had told them the Gospel stories had likely already died; not to mention the fact that the writers were also being ostracized by the mainstream Jewish community, so it stands to reason that they tried to make sense out of what they were doing.

What they were doing, really, was simply celebrating the Eucharist. (Not all that different than we are today.) But then, what is the Eucharist? At mass, in the “breaking of bread” we connect to Jesus’ real presence and His sacrifice because the consecration connects us all to the event of Jesus.

Furthermore, the Hebrew form of thought was holistic: there is no separation between mind, heart, soul, or body. Basically, “what you see is what you get.” So, by receiving Jesus in the physical act of the Eucharist, we move beyond merely “what we see” and are better able to grasp the presence of Jesus in what we do.

In the same way, what we do connects us to each other. For, we are not alone when we receive Jesus in this physical way at mass. We are both individually transformed by Jesus and brought together as one.

I thank the inspired writers of John for helping us see the Eucharist with depth and clarity by putting these words on the lips of Jesus: “Unless you eat the flesh of the Son of Man and drink his blood, you will not have life within you.”

“I am the living bread that came down from heaven; whoever eats this bread will live forever; and the bread that I will give is my flesh for the life of the world.”
