Aston methodology:

Learning through emotions

Students attending a summer camp to improve their language skills want to have fun and enjoy the experience. They are on holidays, school time is over and they don't want boring lessons. That's why we have designed a methodology with active lessons, where practicing through activities & games (like "run & write", mime, role play, drama, arts & crafts, songs, etc...) make the classes more enjoyable and the students learn actively.

Our method is based on "topics". Each topic has its own vocabulary, and associated grammatical structures, and specific activities and games. Everything is taught using games, songs and role playing, but never forgetting grammar. Students also prepare the night activities, for example a song that they will perform that night. They will return home feeling proud of what they learned while they were having fun and this is our aim.

We offer three language levels. Groups are made up of approximately 12 students per class.

Academic Programme

Football Training

3h training four days a week with professional coaches plus a daily match so that campers put in practice all they have learnt during training sessions. Training sessions and matches focus on skills like passing, controlling, keeping the ball, dribbling and shooting and the way to put all that into practice in real-time situations. Some workshops deal with various physical, psychological, tactical and technical aspects of the sport, which stress notions such as fair play, coaching, training, goals, endurance and attitude.

Dance Training
