This meeting shall be a Multi-Club Hillclimb, conducted under the International Sporting Code of the F.I.A., the National Competition Rules (NCR) of the Confederation of Australian Motor Sport Ltd (CAMS), Speed Events Standing Regulations, Hillclimb Standing Regulations and these Supplementary Regulations, and any further regulations which may be issued. The event will be held under and in accordance with the CAMS OH&S and Risk Management Policies, which can be found at www.cams.com.au

ELIGIBILITY TO COMPLETE

Financial members of a club affiliated with CAMS in Victoria are eligible to enter. Current CAMS Level 2SJ Licence or superior, CAMS vehicle Log Book (if issued), Competition Record (if issued) and current Club Membership card must be presented or purchased prior to scrutiny.

PENTATHLON SERIES

This event will be a round of the CAMS junior Pentathlon series.

ENTRIES

Should be posted to the Competition Secretary at po box 139 Maffra, 3860.
Entries open at the publication of these regulations and close **last mail 21/07/2010**

Series Entry Drivers who have completed their Series Entry Form at least 4 weeks prior to the event have their place reserved by the organisers until 5pm Wednesday **21 July 2010**. If no entry is received by a Series Entry Driver by this date, their reserved entry is forfeited.

Entry fee ADULTS is \$55, Entry fee JUNIORS is \$35.

All entries to be lodged with a completed entry form.

Organisers reserve the right to refuse any entry in accordance with NCR83.

THE FIELD WILL BE RESTRICTED TO THE FIRST 120 ENTRIES.

SCRUTINY

Shall be conducted at the track at **11.00 am**

PRACTICE

One practice run per driver may be permitted at a time designated by the clerk of course. This will only occur following confirmation of driver/s entry and scrutiny of the competing vehicle.

DRIVERS BRIEFING

Begins at **12.45pm** and **MUST** be attended by all drivers.

STARTING ORDER

Starting will be in numerical order although not necessarily starting from zero. The starting point will be selected at the discretion of the competition secretary, in consultation with the Clerk of Course.

START

Timed runs begin at **1.00 pm**. Competitors will be allowed as many runs as possible.

DRIVER REQUIREMENTS

Drivers must wear a helmet to a standard listed in the **current** CAMS Manual of Motor Sport (schedule D) and deemed by the scrutineers of the event to be in a suitable condition for use in motor sport. Ankle to wrist to neck non-flammable clothing, suitable footwear & a properly fastened seat-belt.

PERSONAL ACCIDENT

In accordance with Appendix I, all competitors and drivers will be covered by CAMS personal accident insurance during the event.

VEHICLE REQUIREMENTS

A fire extinguisher complying with Schedule H of the **current** CAMS manual must be mounted in a suitable location. Halon extinguishers are now illegal. Competitors attention is also drawn to Section 6 (Schedules A and B) in the **current** CAMS manual, to which all vehicles must comply. All vehicles are to be fitted with suitable front and rear towing hooks, which must be clearly marked.

Exhaust noise is to be restricted to 95dB

TYRES

Rally Tyres are allowed but, if fitted, **MUFLAPS MUST BE OF A SUITABLE RIGID MATERIAL AND COMPLETELY OBSCURE THE TYRE PROFILE TO WITHIN 80MM OF THE GROUND.**

FUEL

Must be in accordance with Schedule G of the CAMS Manual. NO fuel will be available at the track.

ALCOHOL

During any event, consumption of alcoholic beverages in the paddock, pits or any other portion of the competition venue under the control of the officials is expressly forbidden until all practice or competition activity is concluded for each day. Any driver or crew member who is found to be affected by alcohol on the day of the event or practice therefore shall not be permitted to participate. Refer NCR 145A of the Current CAMS Manual.

In addition, the persons concerned will be subject to the Articles of the Procedure for Alcohol Testing and CAMS Drugs in Sport Policy. Competitors, crews or officials may be tested for alcohol or other drugs at any time during the event(s). This regulation serves as the required 24-hour notice to Competitors, Crew and Officials.

CATERING

Full Catering will be provided by the MADCC

TIMING

The event will be electronically timed. Timing will be to the hundredth of a second. The Timekeeper/Clerk of Course will act as Judge of Fact.

ABANDONMENT & POSTPONEMENT

The organisers reserve the right to postpone, abandon or cancel the meeting in accordance With NCR 59 of the **current** CAMS manual

PROTESTS

Protests must be lodged in accordance with Part XII of the NCR.

CLASSES (Drivers will be graded into the following classes)

- A 0-2000cc Standard (2WD, Road Tires Only, No Driveline Modifications Allowed)
- B Over 2000cc Standard (2WD, Road Tires Only, No Driveline Modifications Allowed)
- C 0-1600cc Modified (2WD, No Firewall Modifications, Similar Engine Only (Make & No of cyl)
- D 1601-2000cc Modified (2WD, No Firewall Modifications, Similar Engine Only (Make & No of cyl)
- E Over 2000cc Modified (2WD, No Firewall Modifications, Similar Engine Only (Make & No of cyl)
- J Juniors – Aged 14 -18yo as of 1st January 2010
- L Ladies
- S Specials (Custom built cars and excessively modified sedans)
- W Production Based 4WD or AWD (no tire restrictions apply)

The Competition Secretary in conjunction with the chief scrutineer, and Clerk of Course reserve the right to reclassify any entry.

TROPHIES

Will be presented for Outright 1st, 2nd & 3rd.

1st in class (2 or more entries)

2nd in class (>5 entries)

3rd in class (> 10 entries)

TRAILER PARKING

Trailers must not be parked in the Pits or spectator areas. They must be parked in the Trailer Park opposite the Pits near the finish line or in other areas at the direction of officials.

PIT CONDUCT

Cars not competing (i.e. support vehicles) must not be parked in the Pits. All competing cars are to keep to a 10km/h speed limit that applies to ALL access roads to and around the Pit area. Failure to do so could result in exclusion from the event.
