Selection is based on outstanding academic excellence throughout the applicant's high school and post-secondary (as appropriate) career, exceptional contribution to school, community life and/or other meaningful pursuits, major accomplishments and a strong indication of academic promise.



Proceeds of the annual John E. Lowes Breakfast Seminar help to assist qualified scholarship recipients further their education and establish their careers. Since 2001, ninety-nine percent of all recipients are now employed full-time within the Property & Casualty Insurance Industry.
