खिताब से दूर रह गए आदित्य

भारत के आदित्य मेहता ने तीन लाख पाउंड के इंडियन ओपन विश्व स्नूकर रैंकिंग टूर्नामेंट के फाइनल में पहुंच कर शुक्रवार को नया इतिहास रचा, लेकिन फाइनल में वह चीन के डिंग जुनहुई से 0-5 से हार गए। आदित्य ने सेमीफाइनल में विश्व के पांचवें नंबर के खिलाड़ी स्कॉटलैंड के स्टीफन मैग्वायर को रोमांचक संघर्ष में 4-3 से हरा कर किसी प्रोफेशनल टूर्नामेंट के फाइनल में पहुंचने वाले पहले भारतीय बनने का इतिहास रचा था। लेकिन विश्व रैंकिंग में चौथे नंबर के डिंग ने आदित्य को 76-36, 87-0, 107-0, 93-1, 116-1 से हराया।

India's Aditya Mehta created a history on Friday by reaching the final of £300,000 Indian Open World Snooker Ranking Tournament. But in the final he lost to China's Ding Junhui by 0-5. In the semi-final Aditya defeated World No. 5 Scotland's Stephen Maguire by 4-3 and became the first Indian to reach the final of a professional tournament. World No. 4 Ding ended Aditya's dream run by defeating him 76-36, 87-0, 107-0, 93-1, 116-1.

आईटी क्षेत्र में इस साल 1.65 लाख नौकरियां मिलेंगी

टीसीएस, इंफोसिस और आईटी क्षेत्र की अन्य कंपनियां इस साल ज्यादा नियुक्तियां करेंगी। दूसरी तिमाही में आमदनी बढ़ने और मांग में आई तेजी की वजह से कंपनियां ज्यादा नियुक्ति करने की तैयारी कर रही हैं। आईटी क्षेत्र की संस्था नैसकॉम की वरिष्ठ उपाध्यक्ष संगीता गुप्ता ने कहा कि नियुक्तियों में तेजी आ रही है। उन्होंने जुलाई में कहा था कि चालू वित्तीय वर्ष में आईटी क्षेत्र में 1.50 लाख नई नियुक्तियां होंगी। अमेरिका और यूरोप में आईटी खर्च बढ़ने, आउटसोर्सिंग में इजाफे और डॉलर के मुकाबले कमजोर रुपये की वजह से देश की आईटी कंपनियों की कमाई में जोरदार बढ़ोतरी हुई है।



TCS, Infosys and other companies of IT will hire more people this year. Due to the increase in the income and increase in the demand in the second quarter the companies are coming up with more openings. NASSCOM's Vice President Sangeeta Gupta told that the hiring has increased. In July, she said that in the current financial year 1.50 will be hired. Due to the increase in IT expenditure in America and Europe and weak rupee Vs dollar has resulted in the considerable rise in the income of IT companies.



युगल रैंकिंग के टॉप-10 में फिर हुई सानिया की वापसी

भारतीय टेनिस स्टार सानिया मिर्जा डब्ल्यूटीए की ताजा विश्व रैंकिंग में दो पायदान ऊपर चढ़ कर फिर से युगल में शीर्ष दस में शामिल हो गई हैं। इस महीने के शुरू में जिम्बाब्वे की कारा ब्लैक के साथ चाइना ओपन का खिताब जीतने वाली सानिया दो पायदान चढ़ कर नौवें स्थान पर पहुंच गई हैं। इस बीच एटीपी युगल रैंकिंग में रोहन बोपन्ना (पांचवें), लिपंडर पेस (10वें), महेश भूपति (14वें) और दिव्जि शरण (70वें) की रैंकिंग में कोई बदलाव नहीं हुआ है।

Indian tennis ace Sania Mirza has broken back into the top 10 of the world women's doubles by gaining two spots to ninth place in the latest WTA Team Rankings. Sania had won back-to-back titles as she lifted the China Open trophy earlier this month, followed by another triumph in Pan Pacific Open in Tokyo with Zimbabwe's Cara Black. In the ATP doubles ranking there has been no change in Rohan Bopanna (5th), Leander Paes (10th), Mahesh Bhupathi (14th) and Divij Sharan (70th) ranking.

Somedev Devvarman



टेनिस जगत के उमरते सितारे सोमदेव देववर्मन ने भारत को कई मौकों पर बड़ी सफलता दिलाई है। अर्जुन पुरस्कार से सम्मानित सोमदेव कुछ समय से चोट की वजह से खेल से थोड़ा दूरी बनाए हुए थे। लेकिन इस साल शानदार वापसी करने के बाद उन्हें एटीपी वर्ल्ड टूर अवॉर्ड के लिए नामांकित किया गया है।

Somedev Devvarman is the budding star of Indian Tennis. **Born on 13th February 1985 he began playing tennis at age 9. Devvarman started competing in futures tournaments in 2002 aged 17. His biggest achievement during this time was a victory in the Kolkata F2 championship in 2004 after which he rose to 666 in world ranking. He moved to the USA later that year and competed less regularly while at the University of Virginia. Somdev, while at college, won the 2007 NCAA Singles Championship. He hit the headlines for being the only collegiate player to have made three consecutive finals at the NCAA, winning back-to-back finals in his junior and senior years. He won his first career title at a Futures Tournament in Rochester, New York. The University of Virginia retired Devvarman's jersey in 2009. At the end of 2010, he was felicitated by the Tamil Nadu Tennis Association in Chennai. Devvarman reached his first ATP Tour final at the 2009 Chennai Open, the first tournament of the new season, beating two-time Chennai Open champion. In 2010 Devvarman reached the quarterfinals of the SA Open in Johannesburg. He also reached the second round of the ATP World Tour 500 series Dubai Tennis Championships, where he lost against Marcos Baghdatis. He also led India's Davis Cup team in their match against Russia. On 10 October 2010, Somdev won the Men's Tennis gold medal in the Commonwealth Games 2010 at Delhi by beating Greg Jones of Australia in straight sets. On 23 November 2010, Somdev also won the singles gold medal in the 2010 Asian Games at Guangzhou, China. Somdev rose to a career high ranking of no. 94 on 25 October, 2010. In 2011, Devvarman received the Arjuna Award from the Indian government for his national tennis successes. He began 2012 with a recurring shoulder injury, which ended with him not competing in the first half of the season. Devvarman is now professionally managed by Mahesh Bhupathi's company Globosport. He is sponsored by Lacoste and Babolat. Somdev calls Agartala home, but lives and trains in Austin, Texas. He enjoys blues music, and plays the acoustic guitar. This year he has made one of the biggest comeback this year. A achievement for which he has been nominated Comeback Player of the Year alongside Rafael Nadal, Tommy Robredo and Dmitry Tursunovat this year's ATP World Tour award.**

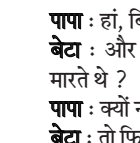
