Associate in Arts Degree - DIGITAL MEDIA MAJOR (21 Units)

The Digital Media major provides formal training for individuals who seek entry into the rapidly growing field of digital media, encompassing digital video production, audio recording, and digital arts. Students utilize the latest tools to learn about digital editing on computers using industry standard software and operating systems environments. Sizable projects are undertaken in each class providing the students with an opportunity to add the projects to their portfolios and knowledge to their skill sets. Students can apply the skills they learn through this program in digital media to careers in multimedia production, digital video production, digital audio engineering, web design and development, corporate communications and graphic arts. Requirements for an AA degree include courses for the major, plus general education requirements and electives to total 60 units (21 units for the major, 39 units of general education).
