These one-day minimission trips are great opportunities to get your feet wet and serve on mission locally while spending little to no money for your day of service. Many of the Local Serve opportunities are Family Serving Opportunities unless otherwise noted.

KIDS ON MISSION: For kids only (and their parents). These trips range from one day local opportunities to overnight regional opportunities. Any of the options are a great way to get your kids serving on mission.

MINISTRY BLITZ: a short-term mission trip lasting anywhere from two to five days and requiring an overnight stay on location. If you can't commit a whole week or longer for a mission trip, a Blitz may be iust for you! (Adults only unless otherwise noted)

MISSION TREK: a mission trip lasting about a week. These trips take you within the United States as well as to foreign countries and are designed for those who are ready to take the next big step in service. If you feel up to putting in a week of hard work and being a part of a missions team that will impact a community, a Mission Trek is a journey you need to experience. (Adults only unless otherwise noted)

GLOBAL EXPEDITION: Most Global Expedition trips are 10 to 14 days in length and involve travel overseas. These expeditions are higher level trips that provide the opportunity to immerse yourself for a longer period in the targeted community and culture. If you're ready for an advanced challenge, a Global Expedition with Ginghamsburg may be just right. (Adults only unless otherwise noted)

NEW YORK CITY MISSION

Date: April 23-28

Cost: \$499 per person (includes travel by van, some meals, and lodging)

Trip Description: Travel by van to the City that Never Sleeps, to further engage in the Ginghamsburg SERVOLUTION. The team will not build any structures on this trip but instead will go to help build and repair people's spirits and souls. This team will engage in a variety of serving opportunities including Hurricane Sandy aide, ministry to the poor, hopeless, and hungry. This team will also be able to spend time seeing the sights and experiencing much of what NYC has to offer.

Details: Attendance at a Pre-Trip Training and Preparation Meeting is required (date TBD). Team members are also urged to take an optional evangelism training class offered through Ginghamsburg's adult discipleship program—schedule to be announced.

Lodging/Food: Local church's dorm-style accommodations and restaurant food

Who: Adults

Registration Deadline: April 15; Final Payment Due the week of the trip

Notes: Each team member will be responsible for meals in transit. Each team member will be responsible for bringing additional spending money (suggested \$100 or more).

CHICAGO MISSION

In 2005, Ginghamsburg started a SERVOLUTION with the "Extreme Neighborhood Makeover/Disaster Recovery" movement in New Orleans. As of January 2013, Ginghamsburg has sent 77 Disaster Relief Teams to help victims of hurricanes, flooding, and tornados in Louisiana, Mississippi, Iowa, and Kentucky. In 2013 Ginghamsburg teams continue to service this revolution by going to help those still suffering and in need. Much remains to be done in both Kentucky and Louisiana. Join hundreds of servant missionaries from Ginghamsburg to help rebuild homes, restore families, and bring the SERVOLUTION to the hopeless in Kentucky and New Orleans!

SLIDELL, LA (HURRICANE RELIEF WORK)

Travel by van to Slidell (a suburb of New Orleans), and experience the heart-break and devastation of Hurricane Katrina in 2005. Projects may include debris clean up, home rehabilitation, home maintenance, painting, and more. No previous construction experience needed. Cost: \$275

Lodging/Food: Teams will bed down in a local church with mats and cots (Bunk beds may be available in New Orleans). Meals will be prepared together by each team.

Registration and Final Payment Due: One week before the departure of your trip

Note: Each team member will be responsible for meals in transit. Attendance at a Pre-Trip Training and Preparation Meeting is required (date TBD).

JAMAICA - MEDICAL & SERVICE MISSION

February 16-23 \$1,299 July 6-13 \$1,299

July 6-20 \$1,899 (2 week trip)

(All trip costs include airfare, meals, travel insurance and lodging. Depending on the trip other expenses may include medicine for med trips, miscellaneous supplies.)

Trip Description: The Ginghamsburg SERVO-LUTION will return to Jamaica in 2013 to serve through medical mission. Our teams will be hosted through the American Caribbean Experience Organization. The medical part of this opportunity is primarily for trained medical/healthcare professionals to serve the Jamaican people through a variety of medical services in the clinic setting. Non-medical persons can also be a part of this team by providing valuable assistance to the health care professionals. The service and work project part is for individuals of any skill level to serve through painting, making minor repairs, praying for individuals at the clinics, etc. Most Jamaica trips will include R&R time daily, as well as possible side trips to local attractions.

Attendance at Pre-Trip Training and Preparation Meetings is required for participation (date TBD).

Lodging/Food: Local hotel/ local cuisine; cafeteria style food and sack lunches

Who: Adults with skills in any of the following: medical, service and labor

Registration: Due with a \$500 deposit seven weeks before departure Final Payment Due 10 days prior to departure

Notes: Each team member will be responsible for meals during international transit. Each team member will be responsible for getting the necessary shots and immunizations required for this trip—info at cdc.gov. HAITI

Trip One: March 23-30

Trip Two: October 26-November 2

Cost: \$1,699 per person (includes airfare, travel expenses, lodging, food, and ministry)

Trip Description: Here is your chance to bring love and hope to the hearts of the people of Haiti through the Ginghamsburg SERVOLUTION! Haiti is the poorest nation in the western hemisphere and has spent years mired in the hopelessness left from a long history of slavery, violence, voodoo and profound poverty. In 2008 Haiti was struck with four devastating hurricanes in guick succession. In a period of one month they were pounded by Fay, Gustav, Hanna and Ike. The destruction and aftermath of these hurricanes has created a serious crisis for a people who were already living in desperate circumstances. In 2010 massive earthquakes rocked Haiti and sent the country into even more chaos and turmoil. Most of these trips will serving in the Port Au Prince area of the country working in an orphanage, helping tend to medical needs, and serving those in need.

Attendance at Pre-Trip Training and Preparation Meetings is required for participation on this trip (date TBD).

Lodging/Food: Dormitory style housing with separate sleeping quarters for men and women, cafeteria style food

Who: Adults. All skill levels and a heart for "Third World" ministry

Registration: A \$500 deposit for trip one is due 60 days prior to departure

Notes: Each team member will be responsible for meals during international transit. Each team member will be responsible for getting the necessary shots and immunizations required—info at cdc.gov. Each team member will be responsible for bringing additional spending money (suggested \$100-\$200). Each team member will need to acquire a U.S. passport—info at usimmigration-support.org.



COSTA RICA

Date: July 29-July 8

Cost: \$1499 per person (includes airfare, travel expenses, lodging, food, and ministry)

Trip Description: You and your team will begin your SER-VOLUTION with a flight to San Jose, Costa Rica. From there you will bus eight hours south to the La Palma Methodist Church in La Palma, CR on the beautiful Osa Peninsula, which will be your team's work site for the week. Your team's two main tasks will be to continue construction on the only Methodist church on the peninsula as well as construction on a fellowship hall and grounds area. Other activities may include a week-long Bible school for children and help with outreach ministries of the church. This trip is for any skill level, and all adults are welcome. In addition to the missions work, your team will spend one day on the Pacific and possibly tour Poas volcano.

Attendance at Pre-Trip Training and Preparation Meetings is required for participation on this trip (date TBD).

Lodging/food: local hotel, meals cooked and eaten at the work site

Who: 15-20 adults all skill levels and a heart to serve and engage cross culturally

Registration: A \$500 deposit for trip one is due 60 days prior to departure

Notes: Each team member will be responsible for meals during international transit. Each team member will be responsible for getting the necessary shots and immunizations required—info at cdc.gov. Each team member will be responsible for bringing additional spending money (suggested \$100-\$150). Each team member will need to acquire a U.S. passport—info at usimmigrationsupport.org.

UGANDA. AFRICA - ORPHAN MINISTRY TRIP

Dates: May 10-19 Cost: \$3,199 per person

(includes round trip airfare to Uganda, meals, lodging, transportation and some ministry expenses)

Trip Description: Join the SERVOLUTION as Ginghamsburg takes its first ever mission trip to Uganda. Conservative estimates put the world wide orphan population (kids without parents) at over 150 million. In Uganda alone there are over 2.5 million orphans. This trip will focus on meeting the needs of orphans within Uganda as we work with multiple ministries who rescue and provide care for children without any parents. Possible ministry opportunities include Vacation Bible school, construction, medical, outreach, and orphan care. This trip is for any skill level and those with a heart for kids who don't have parents.

Attendance at Pre-Trip Training and Preparation Meetings is required for participation on this trip (date TBA).

Lodging/Food: Hotel style lodging, restaurant style meals

Who: Teachers, medical professionals, business professionals, construction types, and people who love kids

Registration: A \$1000 deposit for trip is due 8 weeks prior to departure

Final Payment: Due May 1

Notes: Each team member will be responsible for meals during international transit. Each team member will be responsible for getting the necessary shots and immunizations required for this trip—info at cdc.gov. Each team member will be responsible for bringing additional spending money (suggested \$200-\$300). Each team member will need to acquire a US passport—info at usimmigrationsupport.org.

SOUTH SUDAN, AFRICA

Dates: July 17- Aug 1 Cost: \$3,699 per person

(Includes round trip airfare and Travel to Yei, South Sudan, meals, lodging, transportation and some ministry expenses)

Trip Description: Join the SERVOLUTION as Ginghamsburg goes back to South Sudan. For over 6 years Ginghamsburg has been serving the people of Sudan and South Sudan through our Christmas Miracle offerings, partnership with UMCOR, and a few trips. This is your opportunity to see firsthand what the United Methodist are doing in Sudan, and get in on the action. This team will join Ginghamsburg missionary, Elizabeth Heft, on the ground in Yei and partner with the United Methodist in their ongoing work in Sudan. Possible ministry opportunities may include medical care, orphan care, orphanage work, and interaction local ministries operating in Yei.

Attendance at Pre-Trip Training and Preparation Meetings is required for participation on this trip (dates TBA).

Lodging/Food: Hotel style lodging, restaurant style meals

Who: Teachers, medical professionals, business professionals, people who love kids, and those with a heart for Sudan and the Third World.

Registration: All participants must be registered and pay a \$1000 deposit for trip by May 15. This team will be limited to only 10 people.

Final Payment: Due July 1

Notes: Each team member will be responsible for meals during international transit. Each team member will be responsible for getting the necessary shots and immunizations required for this trip—info at cdc.gov. Each team member will be responsible for bringing additional spending money (suggested \$200-\$300). Each team member will need to acquire a US passport—info at usimmigrationsupport.org.

- 2. Complete the trip registration form found on the next page and return to Adult Missions at Ginghamsburg Church, 6759 South County Road 25A, Tipp City, Ohio 45371. A non-refundable \$50 registration fee is due with your registration. This fee is applied to the balance of the trip cost. All adults registering for certain trips may be subject to an interview process for acceptance.

Please make note of final registration and deposit deadlines for your trip, listed with each trip description. The deposit can be paid prior to the due date but becomes non-refundable after the designated deadline listed. Your deposit goes toward securing your spot on the trip and is applied toward the balance of the trip cost. Places on each trip are filled "first come, first served," so turn in your deposit and registration as soon as possible.

When your registration and deposit are received, you will receive ongoing updates about trip developments, mandatory pre-trip training classes and information concerning your next steps in preparation to go on mission. You will be expected to attend all of the required pre-trip training/preparation meetings unique to your particular mission trip.
