Each month more than 800 Cambodian children are seen by the AHC dental team. In addition to work performed at the recently renovated clinic, outreach work is performed by the dental team who provide treatment and education to local village health centers, orphanages and schools across the province of Siem Reap.

Along with the full-time Cambodian staff, the department receives volunteer dentists from around the world who donate their time to work alongside the local team.

An agreement with the University of British Columbia Faculty of Dentistry supports an international rotation twice a year with General Practice Residents and DMD students as part of their student electives.

This provides an incredible opportunity for teaching, patient education, and developing a sense of social responsibility as oral health care professionals. The rotation is under the leadership of Dr. Christopher Zed, Associate Dean, Strategic and External Affairs. Learn more at:
