N.B.:- The following document shall be submitted in original.

- (1) A fee of Rs. 700/-
- (2) A Duplicate Registration Certificate.
- (3) An affidavit sworn before 1st class Magistrate.
- (4) Certified extract from the police General Diary containing entry of the information lodged (with the Seal of the police Officer)
- (5) In case of private student, the form should be countersigned by Gazetted Officer under his Official Seal.

IMPORTANT

In case of a total loss of the original Migration Certificate caused by theft, burning etc. the application for issue of a duplicate Migration Certificate must be accompanied with:-

- (i) An affidavit sworn before an Executive First class Magistrate by the guardian, in the case of an applicant below 20 years of age on the date of application, and by the guardian or by the applicant himself, if the applicant is 20 years of age and above, on the date of application. The deponent must in the Affidavit state the date and place of loss and the circumstances under which it was lost.
- (ii) A certified copy of the information lodged with the police or a certified extract from the police Diary, containing the entry of the information lodged, with the seal of the police officer and the Police Station, must be submitted along with the application.
