- 4.) Be ready to make a case for each of the traditions, both your own baptismal and communion preference from scripture and those of others with which you may not agree. (i.e. "What might they be thinking in doing it this way?")
- 5.) Be prepared to discuss who may serve communion or do baptisms as well as who may receive -- in your opinion, from scripture and from tradition.
