Roland Williams, an 8-year National Football League veteran and Super Bowl Champion, graduated from East High School and went on to graduate from Syracuse University and the S.I. Newhouse School of Public Relations at Syracuse University. Upon leaving Syracuse University, Williams was signed by the St. Louis Rams to a three-year contract in the 1998 NFL draft. A multi-year starter for the Rams, Williams played for them when they won Super Bowl XXXIV in the thrilling victory over the Tennessee Titans. Williams then played three years for the Oakland Raiders, before being sidelined by a career-ending injury. In addition to his impressive football career, Williams has received many awards for his charitable

efforts including the prestigious NFL Unsung Hero Award, Oakland Raiders Man of the Year Award, and the Press Radio Club Pro Athlete of the Year Award. As a sports analyst for more than a decade, Mr. Williams has appeared on media outlets including CBS Sports Network, ESPN, MTV, NBC, NFL Network and many others. Currently, he is a motivational speaker, trainer and author of three books, including <u>365 Happy: The Simple & Funny</u> Playbook for Happiness You Really Should Read ASAP.
