Certificate of Achievement Policies

- 1. **Certificates of Achievement** are awarded to deserving 4-H members who are **Juniors** as of January 1st of the current 4-H year. Members must present record book, 4-H Awards Entry Form and recommendation form for consideration. A **maximum of four** Certificates of Achievement will be given in each category based on available resources, and qualifications of applicants.
- 2. The Certificate of Achievement **Recommendation Form** is to reflect the growth of the member as a result of participation in the project or activity during the year as well as the total achievement within the 4-H program during the year. Selection of the member to receive the recognition will be made primarily on the member's growth and accomplishments as shown in his/her record book and leader recommendation
- **3.** Any member who has shown individual achievement and development may be nominated for up to four Certificates of Achievement.
- 4. A member must be **enrolled in the related project** to be considered for a Certificate of Achievement.
- 5. The certificates will be awarded based 50% on their commitment to their project; 25% on club participation and teamwork; 25% on their community service.
- 6. Any leader may nominate a member for a Certificate of Achievement. A 4-H leader from one club may nominate a member of another club.
- 7. Current Record Book, 4-H Awards Entry Form, and Recommendation Form for County Certificate of Achievement are due in the Extension Office by the awards application due date.
