

HISTORY & HIGHLIGHTS

The Harford Day community enthusiastically welcomed the school's first arts festival in November of 2002, with 50 artists from nine states exhibiting and selling their work to an appreciative audience. Arts Festival weekend included a gala Preview Party on Friday evening and the show itself during the day on Saturday. With support of Harford Day parents, alumni, and friends, as well as the general public, the show was a great success in its first year.

There have been ten subsequent Arts Festivals, each building on the success of previous years. And, each show has been highlighted by a sold-out Preview Party that draws more than 300 people. Artists display their work at the show which is open to the general public on Saturday. The school community and the Arts Festival Committee are anticipating another great show in 2013.

GUIDELINES

All work must be original, presented by the creator and executed by hand or with appropriate tools. **Participants must exhibit the type of work shown in their submitted images.** The Director of the Arts Festival retains the right to ask the artist to remove works from booths which are inconsistent with the work in the application. Accepted work includes fine art, high quality fine crafts, limited edition prints (must be signed and numbered), and photography. Dried or pressed flower arrangements, objects made from kits or molds, and food are not acceptable.

BOOTH SPACE

Booth space and location will be assigned by the show committee prior to setup. The use of this space is limited to the artist accepted with the application. Subletting is not permitted.

Booth sizes are listed below. The show is entirely indoors. Tables will be available; no backdrops or dividers will be provided. Booth design must be professional looking and securely constructed. Displays are limited to the specified booth area. Tables must be skirted, and no storage may be visible. Show management reserves the right to remove any display materials which are inappropriate.

Checks should be made payable to Harford Day School.

Acceptance: Jury decisions will be mailed on or before May 31, 2013.

PHOTOGRAPHS/COMPACT DISCS

Please submit four photographs or compact discs containing: three images representing work created in the past two years and one image of a recent booth display (work displayed at the show must be consistent with images submitted). Provide a brief description of each image on the application. Label each photograph or CD with your name and the medium used. All images of unaccepted entries will be returned at that time. Images of accepted work will be returned at the conclusion of the show. (Slides are no longer accepted by the jury.)

REFUND POLICY

Submission of an application is a commitment to participate in the show. No refunds will be given after June 1, 2013. We will return the booth fee if the show is canceled.
