**General Summary of Function/Purpose of Position**

Under the supervision of the Medical Director and the Disease Prevention Manager this position will provide services to men, women and teens seeking treatment for sexually transmitted infections. General duties include interviewing clients, reviewing health histories, providing health education on the avoidance of sexually transmitted infections and assessing clients to identify additional health care and social needs. This position will assure that clients who have additional needs are referred to other programs at either IPH or an external agency, as appropriate. This position will be responsible for administering appropriate treatment for sexually transmitted infections. Additional duties will include meeting with the Medical Director to review cases, attending required meetings and trainings and working as a member of a healthcare team.
