Rules / Consequences



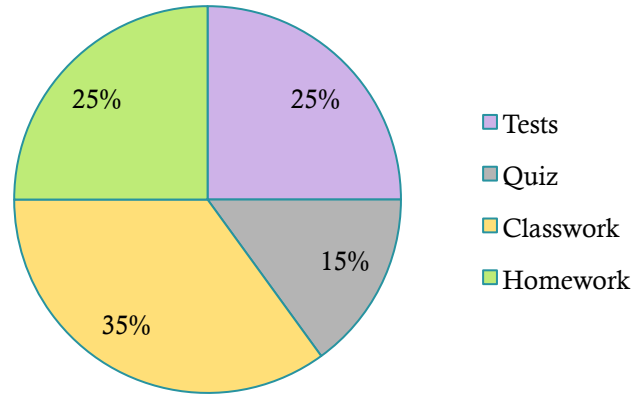
