GENERAL INFO

Garbage bags will be prescribed from April 2009.

- O Q and A about garbage bags
- Q: Where can we buy the prescribed bags?
- A: You can buy them at retail stores including supermarkets, convenience stores, and home improvement stores.
- Q: Until when can we use the present bags?
- A: You can use them until Mar 31, 2009.
 - From April 1, 2009, only the prescribed bags can be used.

Both the present bags and the prescribed bags can be used <u>between Oct 1, 2008 and Mar 31, 2009.</u> If you have many of the present bags remaining, please use them early. In the case that you cannot use all bags by Mar 31, 2009, you can use them as linings for the prescribed bags or put old clothes into for collecting day of recycling resources.

Q: What kinds of bags are there?

A: There are 3 kinds of bags. They each have a different color.

- ① For Burnable garbage · · · Yellow with red letters
 - (2) For Unburnable garbage $\cdot \cdot \cdot$ Transparent with blue letters
 - ③ For plastic garbage · · · White translucent with black letters
 - Size of bags

For each of the above, there are three types of capacity; 45 L, 30 L, 15 L. !! Be careful not to buy prescribed bags from other cities. !!


