## **Kinesiology Taping for Geriatrics**

Strategies for Stroke, Pain, Posture and Improving Functional Outcomes

By the year 2050, one of every 5 people living in the United States will be age 65 or older. With this increase a surge in musculoskeletal, integumentary and neurological disorders (e.g. stroke, arthritis, and edema) is expected. These trends necessitate effective, non-invasive treatment strategies to address impairments associated with these conditions. For several decades, therapeutic taping has been used to improve patient function, correct postural imbalances, reduce pain, and prevent injury. While kinesiology taping is widely used in athletics, it has yet to reach its full potential in geriatric settings.

This hands-on, one day workshop is designed to guide participants through appropriate therapeutic taping applications for the expanding geriatric population. Participants will focus on the fundamentals and techniques of taping as well as specific applications appropriate for this population including pain, edema, shoulder subluxation, stroke rehab, applications to improve posture and positioning, and many more. Participants will leave this workshop with non-invasive, practical methods of managing conditions specific to this population. Taping techniques learned can be used in virtually any environment with few contraindications.
