Youth Camps

FOOTNOTES Be part of a Wanakee tradition. Work on putting together a concert with singing, music, and dance. Bring your instrument and learn and perform Saturday's amazing concert. **Grades 4-12**

GAMES, GAMES, GAMES Spend time learning and playing some classic indoor and outdoor games (like checkers and marbles), and take time to learn some new games. **Grade 2-3**

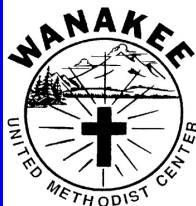
