

BANGOR AREA OPERATION GRADUATION 2015

COMMENCEMENT NIGHT CONTRACT **Please sign and return this portion.**

The use or possession of alcohol, tobacco products, and/or drugs will not be tolerated. All graduates going to the party will submit to a search of their person and their belongings before boarding the bus. Any items deemed inappropriate by chaperones will be cause for refusal of participation. The parents will then be contacted to escort their child home. Once graduates have been searched and enter the main cafeteria, they will NOT be permitted to return to cars or leave the cafeteria. If a situation arises that a chaperone deems it is necessary for a graduate to leave the area, that person must be searched again upon reentry.

While at the party, any graduate found in possession of, using, or showing the effects of alcohol or other drugs, will be detained in the sick room until a parent or guardian is summoned to pick him/her up. If a parent cannot come, the police will be contacted.

Cell phones and any other Internet/text capable devices are NOT permitted at Operation Graduation in order to preserve the alcohol/drug free event. Graduates are encouraged to leave these devices at home. Devices will be locked in the High School office overnight if they are brought to the school prior to departure for the event. Devices will be returned at the conclusion of breakfast at the High School. If a student is found to have possession of a cell phone or other Internet capable device at the event their parents will be called to pick them up. Chaperones will have cell phones in the case of extreme emergencies. In case of an EXTREME emergency, parents may call Mr. Krohn or Mr. Berger the night of the event. Their numbers are located on the attached information sheet for parents to keep.

Graduates who do not ride the bus to the party will not be allowed to attend the party later unless arrangements are made with and approved by Mr. Krohn in advance.

Graduates who sign up for Operation Graduation but do not show up will have their parents called prior to leaving the High School to confirm parents know where their children are located.

Graduates attending the party agree to accept full responsibility for their actions at the party. This liability includes all damages caused by the participant to either the facilities or individuals.

Graduates will treat Operation Graduation chaperones and the employees of the location with respect and courtesy.

Graduates will adhere to the rules imposed by the location in areas of various activities. Time limits for activities must be strictly adhered. No graduates may be in any unlighted areas at any time.

Graduates will check in with the chaperones assigned to them at designated times and places throughout the night.

Dress for the party will be casual. It is expected that you will use good judgment. Bathing suits are required for swimming. Cutoffs are not allowed for swimming.

To be eligible to attend, graduates must:

- A. Comply with all of the above rules
- B. Go through the graduation ceremonies and qualify to receive a diploma.
- C. Have signed up for the event with a signed contract by the deadline

If students have dietary concerns, such as food allergies, they are encouraged to see Mr. Krohn in advance. Graduates will be permitted to bring their own snacks in the case of food allergies.

The student and a parent must sign the permission form below stating that they have read and understand the rules and agree to abide by them.

Seniors may not sign their parent's name-even if the student is 18 years of age or older. Forged signatures will be grounds for refusal to attend the party.

REMEMBER-YOU ARE REPRESENTING BANGOR AREA HIGH SCHOOL AND SHOULD EXHIBIT APPROPRIATE BEHAVIOR AT ALL TIMES.

Detach and return the signed permission slip to MRS. HARRIS by May 15, 2015. This will serve as a permission slip for Operation Graduation and must be in the possession of Mrs. Harris/Mr. Krohn before the student will be permitted to board the bus. All permission slips with names received after the due date will be placed on a waiting list.
