## The New Form 990: What Hospitals Need to Do Now Webinar

### PROGRAM OVERVIEW

Hospitals today are recognizing the need to re-emphasize their charitable mission in fulfilling community benefit expectations. With rising health care costs and concerns about quality and safety, there is a cry for increased transparency and accountability. Federal, state and local governments are scrutinizing whether not-for-profit hospitals are meeting expectations in exchange for tax exemption. Consumers and employers are looking for new approaches to rising healthcare costs and looking to hospitals, the community's largest healthcare entity, as key partners.

In this era of increased emphasis on community benefit, hospitals must be able to accurately plan and report community benefit. Beginning in 2009, non-profit hospitals will need to report community benefit on the new IRS 990 Schedule H. This webinar will discuss how calculating & reporting community benefit will be advantageous to all hospitals and identify the steps for hospitals to begin defining & collecting data for calculating community benefit.

### FACULTY

**RICH SANDERS** is a Partner in Balch & Bingham's Atlanta office and directs the Healthcare Practice Group in Atlanta. Mr. Sanders represents a variety of healthcare providers and managed care organizations on a broad range of issues including fraud and abuse compliance, antitrust policy, physician self referral management, medical staff credentialing, Medicare reimbursement, legislative activities, and business transactions.
