TOUR COSTS

A first deposit of \$2,000 is due as April 15, 2015. Second deposit of \$3,000 due NO LATER THAN May 15, 2015 and the remaining balance due NO LATER THAN July 1, 2015.

SINGLE SUPPLEMENT


