In this seven-hour workshop, participants will earn 7 CEUs and have the opportunity to learn about:

1. Procedures of role induction/orientation with a new supervisee
2. Contributions of both the supervisor and the supervisor toward a working alliance
3. Developmental stages of both the supervisor and the supervisee
4. Multicultural/diversity factors that affect the relationship
5. Typical problems in the supervisory relationship
6. Methods to deal with anxiety/resistance issues related to feedback and evaluation of the supervisee

In addition to didactic presentation, video clips will be used for visual learning. There will also be an experiential component as participants will practice some of the skills in small groups.

Dr. Hildy Getz, LPC, LMFT, is Associate Professor Emeritus of Counselor Education at Virginia Tech where she taught Clinical Supervision and provided supervision for practicum and internship students. She a National Certified Counselor and Approved Supervisor. She is also a Clinical Member and Approved Supervisor of the American Association for Marriage and Family Therapy. Dr. Getz is known for her expertise in Clinical Supervision, having presented programs and workshops around the United States. She has published articles about Clinical Supervision in *The Journal of Counseling and Development*, *The Clinical Supervisor*, *Counselor Education and Supervision*, *The Virginia Counselor*, and *The Professional School Counselor*. During her 25 years of experience in school, non-profit and private practice settings, she has provided supervision for people seeking licensure. For the last eight years, she has had a contract with Blue Ridge Behavioral Health to train their licensed professionals in Clinical Supervision.

Currently, Dr. Getz has a small private practice in Roanoke, VA and does some adjunct teaching for VA Tech.
