Raising Support

We ask that you send letters and contact people to partner with you in this opportunity and not just write a check yourself, nor have your parents pay for you.

Salary

You'll be paid \$2000 for the summer experience consisting of a \$1000 stipend for the program as well as \$1000 for your work at boot camps.

Required Qualifications

- At least 20 years old—must have graduated from High School no later than Spring 2012.
- Active in a local church.
- Active in personal or corporate Bible Study (preferably, Inductive Bible Study).
- · Interested in serving and leading students (preferably already demonstrating this interest through involvement in some type of student ministry).
- Willing and able to be an example in your Christian walk.
- Spiritual gifts (speaking gift(s)) equipping you to teach.

Lodging
