Instructions: Flush eyewash station for 3 minutes. Ensure the unit is working properly. If it is, then mark your initials and date in the appropriate box. If not, then note problem and request Facilities service (x2125). Place "Out of Service" sign on unit until repaired.

Schedule: *Department of Public Health regulated infectious agent laboratories are required to perform weekly inspections.*

NOTE: *According to applicable regulatory standard, the eyewash station must be located so that an affected employee can walk to it in 10 seconds (this translates to approximately 55 feet). Work should not be performed so close to the eyewash station that it becomes contaminated.*
